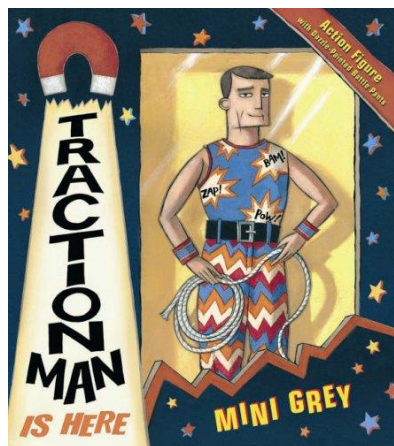


Year 1 Newsletter Term 3
