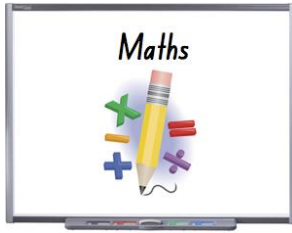


## Year 3 Newsletter

Welcome to term 3. This will help you know what this term holds for learning.

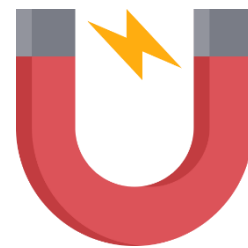


This term, we will continue with multiplication and division, so keep practising the tables we have learnt: 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. Remember, try to learn the divisions too! We will also look at using money in calculations and then go on to data handling and statistics.

Our English starts with a story based on an alternative view of the three little pigs story entitled The True Story of the Three Little Pigs. What could this possibly mean? How could there be another story? We will learn how to structure the important parts of a story and how to use speech accurately. We will also look at how to add interesting detail to our story to hook our reader in. Please don't read the book before though – we want it to be a surprise!



Our Line of Enquiry this term is Science. We will be looking at the topic of magnetism and rocks. We will learn how magnets attract and repel and do experiments to find out which materials they attract. In our study of rocks we will find out how they are formed and use our observation skills to describe them accurately.
