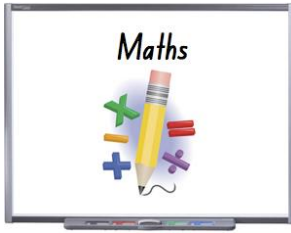


## Year 3 Newsletter

Welcome to term 4. This will help you know what this term holds for learning.



This term, we really want to crack all the tables we have learnt: 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10. Remember, try to learn the divisions too! There will be frequent quick tests to see what you can remember. We will also look at using length and perimeter to explore shapes and then go on to fractions.

Our English will be looking at writing an explanation. We'll start by examining a text connected to a robot cat then we'll move onto writing a text linked to our Line of Enquiry. We will also be encouraging the children to be inventive during the term and write explanation texts for their own inventions they have designed. They will also need to perfect their sales and marketing skills to help Year 3 compete in Enterprise week during the last week of term.

Our Line of Enquiry this term is based on What the Ancient Egyptians did for us! We've already established what we know about this time in history which is a lot but we want to know some more, such as about what they ate, whether children went to school, what they wore and how they dressed. We've also heard of a pharaoh called Tutankhamun and we'd like to know more about him.
