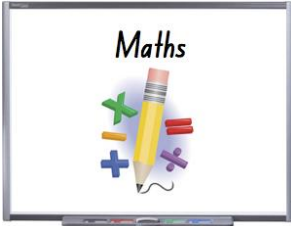


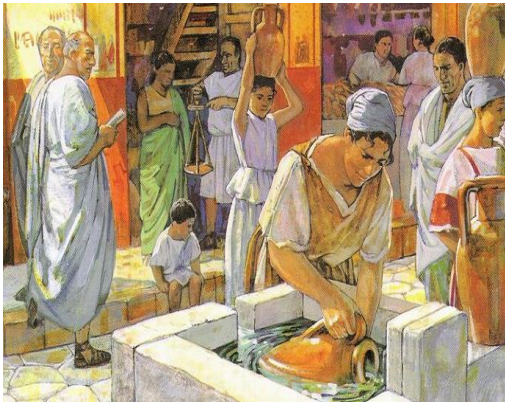
Year 4 Newsletter

Welcome back to Term 4 everyone in Year 4. We hope you find the following information useful.



This term, our main focus will be on Fractions.
We will also be learning the 7 times tables and the related division facts as well as reviewing the facts for the 8 times table learnt in Year 3.

Our English lessons will support our Term 4 line of enquiry: What was life like for the Romans?
We will research what everyday life was like for the Romans and use that information to write a detailed non-chronological report.
What were Roman homes like?
What did they eat? What types of entertainment did the Romans enjoy?



Term 4 is exciting because we look forward to performing our annual production.
Year 4 take on the main acting roles and Year 3 support us brilliantly in the choir.

Children will be taking part in a 10 minute 'Physical Break' every day.
