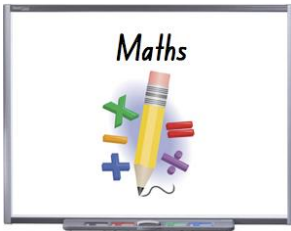


Year 2 Newsletter

Welcome back to our final term in Year 2. We hope you all had a relaxing break and are ready for some exciting learning to take place!



This term, we will be focusing on position and movement, time and measurement. Telling the time at home together would be a great way to support your child. As always we will be practising our times tables daily so please can you help your child with their 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x tables.

Our English lessons this half term will focus on using descriptive language to create a story based on the short film 'Bubbles', writing a formal letter about the environment and producing a report about the what can be found in the ocean. We will continue to learn and practise our spellings and our cursive handwriting.



"Around the world in 5 oceans".

During this Line of Enquiry, children will be finding out about the 5 oceans and 7 continents. We will be using atlases and maps to label the oceans and continents as well as creating fact files about each ocean. We will be learning how to read a compass as well as looking at aerial photographs of different places around the world so it will be a busy half term of learning for Year 2!

PE

We are still taking part in a 10 minute 'Physical Break' every day. On Monday, Wednesday and Friday children complete indoor exercises and on Tuesday and Thursday children are challenged to walk/run a mile.

PE lessons – Rolls Royce (swimming on Tuesday and PE Friday) Concorde (PE on Monday and Wednesday)

It is important that all children are involved in all PE activities. Please ensure that children have a weather suitable P.E. kit and a water bottle in school every day.



A quick reminder that children will be set homework weekly. The homework will be given out on a Monday and needs to be returned on a Friday.

Children will also be given high frequency words to learn every Monday for a spelling test on Friday. Thank you for the support you have given your child with their homework this year.
