Welcome back to Term 6 everyone in Year 4. We hope you find the following information useful.

### Maths



This term, our main focus will be on Time, Statistics and Geometry.

You can help by working on telling the time with your child. We are aiming to be able to use a 24 hour clock eventually!

Our English lessons will enhance our Term 5 line of enquiry: Where is more beautiful North or South America?

We will research both continents and write a fact file for each.

We will also record a traveller's diary across one of the continents after planning a route to take in famous landmarks.



Line of Enquiry: Where is more beautiful North or South America?

We will be:

Discovering the key physical and human characteristics of these continents

Finding out what the major cities are

Using maps and atlases to gather information

Describing features of these continents

Creating an image of a North or South American landmark using sketching, shading and watercolours



Children will be taking part in a 10 minute 'Physical Break' every day.

On Monday, Wednesday and Friday children will be challenged to walk/run a mile; on Tuesday and Thursday we will be completing indoor exercises. On top of this, the children will also have 2 P.E. sessions per week **(Monday & Friday for Brunel; Swimming on Tuesdays & PE on Friday for Cabot).**

It is important that all children are involved in all PE activities. Please ensure that children have a weather suitable P.E. kit and a water bottle in school every day.



A quick reminder that children will be set homework weekly. The homework will be given out on a Monday and needs to be returned on a Friday. This will either be an English or Maths task.

We will not be completing a set weekly spelling test. Children will be expected to revise the statutory word list in their homework books.
