
Congratulations to the following children who were judged best in each class.

Many of you will be aware that a fire occurred at the city farm on Monday last week. The farm offices have been destroyed but the animals are safe. We are considering giving some of the money raised on Red Nose Day and the Enterprise Sale to the farm, with perhaps 20-25% going to the farm and 75-80% going to Comic Relief. You have been sent an email about this and we welcome your views.
