
CURRICULUM AT NOVA

This term children across the school have been developing their scientific knowledge and enquiry skills through their lines of enquiries based on plants and animals. There has been wonderful writing, artwork and outside learning happening in particular.

Below are some great examples from each year group:

Classes aim to tweet photos and information so keep your eyes peeled to find out what's happening in class.

Year R Wallace and Gromit had a very exciting delivery this week - a parcel from an astronaut! We have been asked to train for a very special mission, so we have been researching lots of information about space and have even got our very own space stations in our classrooms!



Year 1 have been busy this term growing beans, creating animal classification posters and writing worm fact files!





Year 2 had a visit from Noah's Ark Zoo Farm and learnt about adaption. The children were able to get up close to a snake, snail, cockroach and tortoise!










Year 3 have been learning how to write a structured third person narrative based on Anthony Browne's fantastic book, Gorilla. They have also progressed to write a balanced argument about the pros and cons of zoos. The line of enquiry 'Which are stronger, plants or animals?' has seen children focus on everything from the human skeleton to the life cycle of plants. We are also excited about seeing the results of our plant growing competition at the end of this term!

Year 4s learning is set deep in the heart of the dense, steamy rainforest. Their writing, art and much more all has a rainforest theme!






Year 5 have been biology bonkers, looking at living things and how they reproduce. We have been learning about the different ways plants disperse their seeds from the wind to the explosive and seeing if we can create the 'perfect' seed for dispersal!

Year 6 have created brilliant narratives using the animation 'Treasure' as a stimulus.

SATs revision is in full swing with every child working to their personal best - busy, busy, busy! Children have been taking part in fun revision activities including:

- Measuring the diameter and radius of biscuits to ensure they pass the quality control assessment
- Angle measuring shh we wrote on the tables!

A massive congratulations to our Year 5 and 6 netball team this week.


You all worked together phenomenally to win 6-0 against Avonmouth... definitely a victory to be proud of!
