# **CURRICULUM AT NOVA**

We are into Term 2 of our new Nova 'LEARN' Curriculum and children are continuing their History based line of enquiries, learning lessons from the past. Staff have worked hard to plan meaningful and memorable learning opportunities for the children as you can see from some of the learning highlights below. You can find

**Year 2** celebrated the end of their fantastic line of enquiry with a 'Fire' experience day, all related to the Great Fire of London.

Children were able to come to school in fancy dress and we saw a variety of different costumes, including firefighters, King Charles II, people with the plague, Thomas Farriner (the baker) and people dressed as fire!

We then recreated the fire itself by burning down the houses we made earlier in the term. Freshwater Theatre came in to take us back in time to see what life was like for citizens of London in 1666. In the afternoon, Avonmouth Fire and Rescue came in to show us what fire safety is like today... and children even got to use the fire hoses! It was a fantastic day with so much fun and learning taking place! Well done Year 2 team.








Year 5 have been wonderful scientists carrying out lots of investigations. They have tested how waterproof materials are, to find out which would be best to line the inside of a longship and they have also tested the strength of different materials. They have measured in newton metres to find each material's breaking point. They have also been identifying the common factors of numbers.







**Year 6** Year 6 have explored mark-making, using a variety of lines (straight, wavy and zigzags), making shades of colours using watercolours and smudging pastels. Here are just a few poppy inspired pieces of art that demonstrate these skills.
