individuals, but sending a clear message that poor behaviour will not be tolerated. I must thank Janet and Mrs Risley (previously Miss Vaughan!) for their incredible hard work in setting up a wide range of interventions and provision for children who need them. Our new 'Rowan Room' is a wonderful space for younger children to develop their learning and social skills and the 'Secret Garden' is a sensory space for children to engage with tactile and playful activities, learning to express how they feel and become less anxious about the world.

In addition, we have various intervention groups running. These groups tackle many different social and emotional issues such as coping with loss and learning to manage feelings of anger. The world can be a scary place for young people and Nova is committed to doing all we can to prepare them for the challenges they face, today and in the future.

At the start of term, you will have received our revised behaviour policy, which sets out clear consequences for children who are deliberately disruptive, unsafe or unkind to others. Of course, positive reinforcement is more important than anything and the children still love our special Nova postcards, their class recognition boards and the opportunity to be selected as the week's 'Nova Star', with the extra treat of attending 'Hot Chocolate Friday'.

I love baking, hula hooping, live music, art projects



To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of reading at home and school, we will be running a sponsored read between **11<sup>th</sup> October and 18<sup>th</sup> October**.

The project is being organised in conjunction with our local Usborne Organiser, Kerriann Coleman, and all the money raised will go towards brand new books for our school.

# School Meals Supervisory Assistant Vacancy

We require a School Meals Supervisory Assistant to work with our children across our lunchtime from either 12.00pm to 1.00pm or 12.30pm to 1.30pm. You will carry out a range of duties both in the dining hall and outside on either the KS1 or KS2 playgrounds. You will be able to build good relationships with both children and class teachers. You will work as part of a team to deliver high quality play activities and care during the lunch hour.

The role is for 5 hours per week paid at the Bristol Grade 2 rate of £17,364 FTE which equates to £9.00 per hour.

We are committed to safeguarding the welfare of children and expect all staff to share this commitment. An enhanced DBS (formerly CRB) check is required for the successful applicant.


We would also be interested in hearing from people who don't want to commit to a permanent role but would be interested in working on a casual basis.





