

Year 5 Newsletter



This term, our focus will be on decimals. We will be adding and subtracting them, sequencing them and multiplying them by powers of ten.

In English, we will explore and write non chronological reports after researching facts about our solar system.

We will then be writing newspaper reports based on events linked to space.







Line of Enquiry: What makes planet Earth unique?

We will be:

Describing the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.

Using the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Creating a model linking the Earth/sun/moon.

Explaining that unsupported objects fall towards Earth because of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object.

Creating a simulation of a meteor hitting Earth.



We hope you're keeping active! Joe Wicks 30-minute exercise routines are a great way to start your daily timetable. In school, children will also have 2 P.E. sessions per week. It is important that all children are involved in all PE activities. Please ensure that children have a weather suitable P.E. kit and a water bottle in school every day. Children will be updated on P.E. days upon return to school.





A quick reminder that children will have three tasks set each day in the home learning packs – these tasks are re-visiting previous knowledge and introducing our new, exciting Line of Enquiry -What makes planet Earth unique?
