Welcome to Year 3. We are very pleased to see everyone back and keen to learn. We hope you find the following information useful.

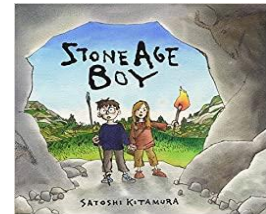
Maths



In this term we will be consolidating the learning from the end of year 2 before moving on to place value - splitting numbers into hundreds, tens and units. We will build on our fluency targets: adding and subtracting one digit numbers from two digit numbers and continue to learn our times tables.

The writing in our English lessons will focus on using our knowledge from the Line of Enquiry lessons alongside our focus book 'Stone Age Boy'.

Our class novel, which we will be using for guided reading, is 'Stig of the Dump' and we will use this to learn to answer questions and make



The children will have P.E. twice a week – once inside and once outside **(Monday and Tuesday/Wednesday for both Vincent and Goram)**. It is important that all children are involved in all PE activities. Please ensure that children have a weather suitable P.E. kit including trainers/daps.

Would you prefer to live in Ancient Egypt or the Stone Age?

We will begin this term by learning about what it was like to live in a Stone Age settlement. We will find out what type of food they ate, the jobs they did and how they survived. They will look at and have a go at creating cave paintings as well as start to write and make some exhibits for an online museum to share with parents/carers later in term 2.



A quick reminder that children need to practise their times tables regularly, along with reading 5 times a week. This will greatly improve your child's progress in school.
