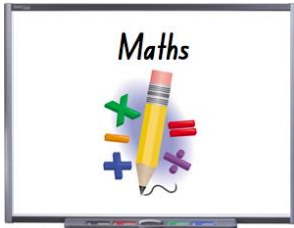


Year 4 Newsletter

This term, we will be focusing our Maths learning on place value, addition and subtraction.

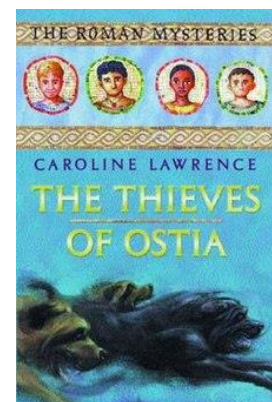
We look at place value to four digits (thousands, hundreds, tens and ones) and applying our previous knowledge of place value to this.

Throughout the term, we will be practising our times tables so please continue to use Times Table Rockstars at home to improve

Our English lessons all be based on our topic of the Romans. Therefore, we will start by exploring the book, 'The Thieves of Ostia' and revising our basic sentence and paragraph structures around this.

We will then begin to study Roman myths, reading many different stories and then will write our own.

Later in the unit, once we have learnt more about the Romans, we will turn this knowledge into non-chronological reports.

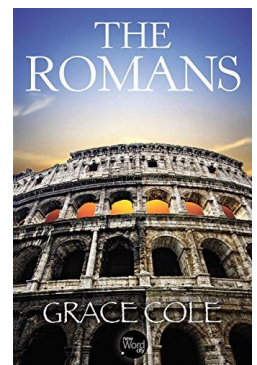


What did the Romans do for us?

In Term 1, we are beginning a new topic surrounding the Roman invasion on Britain and how the Romans' lives affected us.

We will be starting the unit by examining a number of Roman artefacts, looking at what we can learnt from artefacts relating to the Romans. Over the first few weeks, we will answer the question 'Who were the Romans and where did they come from?'

After that, we will focus in the on the lives of Romans. In particular, looking at battles, houses and their inventions.



On Monday, Wednesday and Friday children will be challenged to complete different physical activities.

On top of this, the children will also have 2 PE sessions per week. (**Wednesday morning and Friday afternoon**).

It is important that all children are involved in all PE activities. Please ensure that children have a weather suitable PE kit and a water bottle in school every day.
