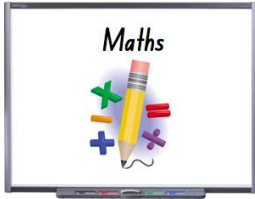


Year 2 Newsletter

Welcome to term 2. We hope you have all had a restful half term and enjoyed some family time. We hope this newsletter gives you an insight into what we will be learning during this term.

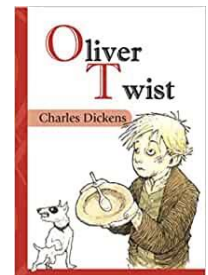


Mathematics

This half term in maths we will be learning our number bonds to 10 and 20. We will be adding and subtracting two digit numbers so children will become more confident with their understanding of place value. We will also be using money in maths to help solve problems. As always, please continue to help your child to learn their 2X, 5x and 10X tables as this will really help when solving different mathematical problems.

English

During our English sessions we will be reading 'Oliver Twist' and writing some character descriptions. We will be acting out scenes from the story and going in role as some of the characters. Towards the end of the term we will be writing a report on life in the Victorian times and how it is different from life today



Line of Enquiry: What was it like to live in Victorian times?

During Line of Enquiry this half term, pupils will draw conclusions about life in the Victorian era for children including those from wealthy and disadvantaged backgrounds. They consider aspects such as housing, clothing and schooling. Towards the end of the term, children will showcase their understanding of life in the Victorian era to others in their year group bubble.

Physical Education
