

Year 1 Home Learning Tasks – Term 1

Maths Number Facts:

This term in class we are focusing on place value, counting to and from 20, one more one less, our 1:1 correspondence and recall of number bonds to 10 and 20 (e.g. $10 + 0$, $9 + 1$, $8 + 2$ / $10 + 10$, $20 + 0$).

My personal maths target:

This term I need to learn my number bonds to 10 and 20 and be able to recall them quickly.

Key words:

All children will bring home a key words book with the year 1 key words list to practise their reading and spellings at home.

My personal spelling target:

This term I need to correctly read and spell my tricky words.

Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them.

All children have a levelled reading book from school which they will change once they have read with an adults at home and their reading records have been signed. Children also have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

My personal reading target:

This term I need to read with an adult, at home, for at least 5 minutes per day.

Suggestions of optional wider curriculum activities:

This term our line of enquiry is 'Who are the real heroes?'

- ❖ **History** – Can you think of three events that have happened in your past? (e.g. birthdays, holidays, family events, day trips).

- ❖ **DT** – Can you create a medal fit for a hero? You can use recyclable resources.

- ❖ **PSHE** – Can you draw and label a family tree?
