

## Year 4 Home Learning Tasks – Term 2

### Maths Number Facts:

All children have a Times Table Rockstar log in. Children should log in and play at least 5x a week at home.

This term in class we will continue to recap our Year 3 times tables (2x, 5x, 10x, 3x, 4x & 8s). We will also be learning the 6x table and practising counting in 25s, 50s and 100s.

### Spelling:

All children have a Spelling Shed log in. Children should log in and play at least 3x a week at home. All children will also bring home the statutory year group spelling list to practise their spellings at home.

### Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them and sign their reading records. Children have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

Most children in Year 3 have a levelled reading book from school which they will change at least weekly. Your child may be a 'free reader' in which case they may change their reading book less often depending upon the length. If still developing their phonics knowledge, children will instead have a decodable phonics book from school which they will change once a week. Children should read their decodable book at least 3x a week at home.

### My personal reading target:

This term I need to focus on reading a variety of different text types (fiction & non fiction)

### Suggestions of optional wider curriculum activities:

This term our line of enquiry is 'Who were the Romans and what was their legacy on Britain?'

- ❖ **History** – Can you find out what life was like in Britain before the Romans came? Who was Boudica? Who lived in Britain when the Romans invaded? How did they live?
- ❖ **Art** – Develop your sketching skills by sketching Roman and Celtic homes.
- ❖ **DT** – Can you practise your sewing skills? Try researching and learning the following: running stitch, back stitch, over stitch.
- ❖ **Maths** – What calculations can you write down using Roman numerals? Write some out and see if an adult at home can solve them!
- ❖ **English** – Use your descriptive writing skills to write a creative story involving Queen Boudica and the Romans.
