Year 3 Home Learning Tasks

Maths Number Facts:

All children have a Times Table Rock Star log in. Children should log in and play at least 5x a week at home.

This term we count in multiples of 50 and 100 and consolidate the 3x, 4x and 8x multiplication and division facts.

Spelling:

All children have a Spelling Shed log in. Children should log in and play at least 3x a week at home.

All children will also bring home the statutory year group spelling list to practise their spellings at home.

Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them and sign their reading records. Children have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

Most children in Year 3 have a levelled reading book from school which they will change at least weekly. Your child may be a 'free reader' in which case they may change their reading book less often depending upon the length.

If still developing their phonics knowledge, children will instead have a decodable phonics book from school which they will change once a week. Children should read their decodable book at least 3x a week at home.

Wider Curriculum:

How can science educate and entertain us?

- ❖ **Geography** – Research an invention that uses forces, magnets or electrical circuits and has had a positive impact on the environment.
- ❖ **Art** – Sketch a portrait of a famous scientist that interests you. Experiment with shade and tone for effect.
- ❖ **DT** – Create a board game using your scientific knowledge of forces e.g. a mechanism that you push or pull, a mechanism that is magnetic.
- ❖ **Maths** – Complete a survey of all of the electrical items you have in your home. Present your findings in a tally and bar-chart.
- ❖ **English** – Research the life of a famous scientist that interests you. Write a non-fiction recount about a day in their life.
- ❖ **Science** - Conduct a science experiment at home relating to forces and magnets e.g. experiment with making paper aeroplanes out of range of materials and see which one can fly the furthest before gravity pulls it back down to Earth. Report and write an explanation of your results.
- ❖ **Make sure you ask permission and get support from an adult at home!**

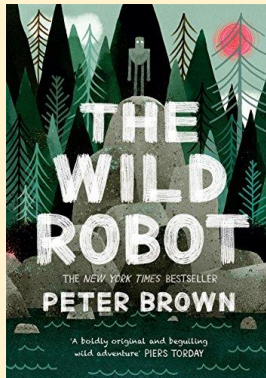
