

Year 2 Home Learning Tasks – Term 5 & 6

Maths Number Facts:

All children have a Times Table Rockstar log in. Children should log in and play at least 5x a week at home.

This term in class we will be consolidating all the Year 2 times tables 2's, 5's and 10's.

My maths target:

This term I need to learn how to find a half a third and a quarter. I need to practice telling the time.

Spelling:

All children have a Spelling Shed log in. Children should log in and play at least 3x a week at home. All children should also have a list of year 2 common exception words to practice at home.

My personal spelling target:

This term I need to practice 'er', 'est', 'ed', 'ing' endings.

Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them and sign their reading records. Children have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

Most children in Year 2 have a levelled reading book from school which they will change at least weekly.

If still developing their phonics knowledge, children will instead have a decodable phonics book from school which they will change once a week. Children should read their decodable book at least 3x a week at home.

My personal reading target:

This term I need to answer questions about the pages I just read.

Wider Curriculum:

What makes Africa Amazing?

- ❖ **Geography** – Choose and research a country in Africa that interests you. Present your findings in a creative way e.g. poster, booklet, non-chronological report, video etc.
- ❖ **Art** – Research African patterns and create your own African kente cloth.
- ❖ **DT** – Create an interactive pop-up book on your favourite African animal.
- ❖ **Maths** – Create a daily or weekly personal timetable. Include the start time and finish times using a clock face.
- ❖ **English** – Write an adventure story about a talking animal. Use questions and conjunctions to develop your writing skills.
- ❖ **Science** – Research animals that live in the same environment.

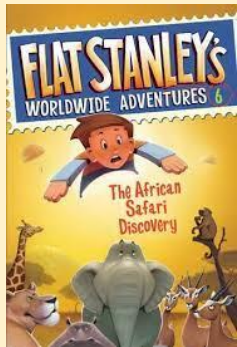
