

Year 4 Home Learning Tasks – Term 5

Maths Number Facts:

All children have a Times Table Rockstar log in. Children should log in and play at least 5x a week at home.

This term, we will be exploring decimals, money problems and time.

My personal maths target:

This term I need to learn all X table facts up to 12- including division facts ready for the Multiplication Check in June.

Spelling:

All children have a Spelling Shed log in. Children should log in and play at least 3x a week at home. All children will also bring home the statutory year group spelling list to practise their spellings at home.

My personal spelling target:

Use homophones accurately E.g. seen/scene

Use c and i together accurately E.g. ceiling/believe

Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them and sign their reading records. Children have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

Most children in Year 4 have a levelled reading book from school which they will change at least weekly. Your child may be a 'free reader' in which case they may change their reading book less often depending upon the length. If still developing their phonics knowledge, children will instead have a decodable phonics book from school which they will change once a week. Children should read their decodable book at least 3x a week at home.

My personal reading target:

Review a book that you have enjoyed at home and share it with the class.

Suggestions of optional wider curriculum activities:

This term our line of enquiry is 'What is so important about chocolate?'

- ❖ **Computing – Use your computing skills to present your findings in other subjects. Example: Make a PowerPoint about your science knowledge! Create a poster to show your knowledge of the Maya people.**

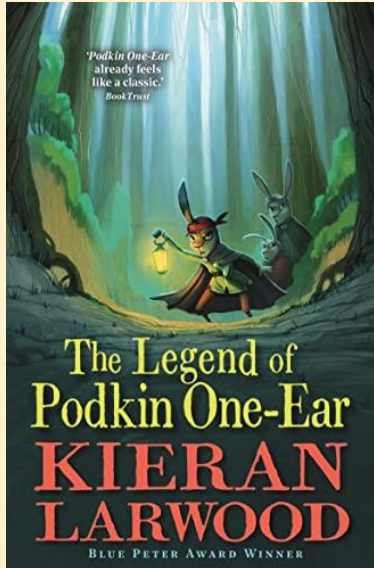
