Q: Have gaps closed? A: No. Q: Is it getting worse? A: Yes. More SEND (Special Education Needs and Disadvantaged) pupils in school.</li> <li>Finance/budget issues eg escalating fuel bills are making it difficult to provide the resources required.</li> <li>OFSTED</li> <li>Q: When is school likely to be inspected again? A: Last inspection was in July 2022, next expected to be around July 2026.</li> <li>Nova will continue to go down to one form entry route.</li> <li>Head reminded Governors of the EYFS problem when Ofsted came, which has now been completely transformed. Communication with parents was raised by Ofsted but now much improved.</li> <li>Parents/carers are being invited into school more eg Celebration Assemblies; regular visits to classrooms to see children's work.</li> <li>After the October holiday they will be able to meet with teaching staff. A survey will also be carried out.</li> <li>Governor focus 2023-24</li> <li>EYFS – Learning Environment + Parental engagement + Transition to Y1 + Resilience</li> <li>Head confirmed school is very good at applying and receiving Top-Up Funding for those pupils that qualify, and for sign-posting families to support groups that Nova does not have access to.</li> <li>Governors thought school was creative with the resources they have within school budget.</li> </ul>
