

Year 3 Home Learning Tasks – Terms 1 and 2

Maths Number Facts:

From term 2, all children have a Times Table Rockstar log in. Children should log in and play at least 5x a week at home.

This term, in class, we are focusing on recapping our Year 2 multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will also be recapping our number bonds to 10 and 20 and learning the 3x and 4x tables.

My personal maths target:

Review 2x, 5x and 10x tables. and focus on division facts of 2x, 5x and 10x tables

Spelling:

All children have a Spelling Shed log in. Children should log in and play at least 3x a week at home. All children will also bring home the statutory year group spelling list to practise their spellings at home.

My personal spelling target:

To learn my year 3 and 4 statutory spelling list – you can find these on page 3 of your KS2 family reading record.

Reading:

Children should read at least 5x a week at home to an adult. We encourage adults to discuss children's reading with them.

All children have a levelled reading book from school, which they will change at least weekly. Your child may be a 'free reader' in which case they may change their reading book less often depending upon the length. Children also have access to wider interest books from their class and school library.

My personal reading target:

To practise reading daily with an adult.

Suggestions of optional wider curriculum activities:

This term our line of enquiry is 'Would you prefer to live in Stone Age Britain or Ancient Egypt?'

- ❖ **History** – Can you research facts about an Egyptian Pharaoh. Present your findings in an interesting way e.g. PowerPoint/ video recording/ booklet.
- ❖ **Art** – Develop your sketching skills by sketching Stone Age cave art.
- ❖ **DT** – Can you create a model of an Egyptian pyramid?
- ❖ **Maths** – Can you research how the Egyptians used hieroglyphics to represent numbers (hundreds, tens and ones).
- ❖ **English** – Use your knowledge of the Stone Age to write an adventure story for your own Neolithic character. Include an interesting description of your setting and character to engage the reader.
